Starting your first locum assignment doesn't have to be overwhelming. Use this checklist to stay organized and prepared before day one.

## Licensing and compliance

- Obtain required state licenses (RN, NP, furnishing license if applicable)
- Update DEA registration for your state of practice (if applicable)
- Keep copies of all active licenses and certifications

## Credentialing and documentation

Complete credentialing requirements, including:

- Professional references
- Immunization/health records
- Updated CV and skills checklist
- Malpractice history
- Licenses and certifications
- Continuing education and BLS/ACLS

Scan and store all required documents digitally

## Travel and housing

- Join airline and hotel rewards programs
- Book travel (flight and rental car) with your LocumTenens.com contact
- Confirm housing arrangements (hotel or furnished housing)

## Packing essentials

- Work attire per site guidelines
- Comfortable work shoes
- Stethoscope and white coat
- Notebook and pen
- Casual clothing for days off

## Orientation and first-day prep

- Review orientation schedule and first-day instructions
- Review contract details and scheduled shifts
- Communicate any required time off



**Bring valid personal identification**  
(Some facilities require a passport on day one)
